**Free online speech pathology clinic
for children under school age**

Speaking Spot Bendigo is a telehealth clinic for parents and carers to discuss their child's speech, language, fluency, voice or feeding concerns with a Speech Pathologist and Maternal & Child Health Nurse.

This free service is available for children from birth to school entry.

Come along if you:

- want ideas to support your child's communication
- want to check if your child's speech and language is age appropriate
- have any general concerns about your child's development

Your child can attend but does not need to be present. Sessions include a brief discussion about your child's development and suggestions to help your child. Referral to Bendigo Health Community Health Speech Pathology may be made after your session.

Telehealth Instructions:

1. Please use a laptop or computer as telehealth does not work well on a phone
2. Open a Google Chrome or Microsoft Edge internet window
3. Type this link in the search bar: <https://videocall.direct/speakingspotbendigo>
4. Log on with your child's full name
5. You will enter a virtual waiting room - a staff member will add you to the call when it is your turn to be seen. You can wait online until a Speech Pathologist and Maternal & Child Health Nurse are available.
