The Position

The Residential in Reach (RIR) team sits within the Community and Continuing Care Services division and is currently jointly managed with the Transition Care Program.

RIR nursing staff are highly skilled and experienced clinical practitioners who triage and plan the acute clinical care of referred residents. Staff work independently over either a morning or afternoon shift (0700 – 2100 hours) 7 days a week, and are tasked with responding to telephone referrals in a timely fashion

Responsibilities and Accountabilities

Key Responsibilities

Clinical Responsibilities

- Receive and respond promptly to referrals from Residential Aged Care Facilities, General practitioners, the Bendigo Health Emergency Department and other community providers for clients with deterioration
- Provide comprehensive nursing assessment and intervention of clients with complex issues in accordance with evidence-based practice.
- Collaborate with relevant multidisciplinary team members to achieve desired health outcomes for clients
- Liaise with other community-based services to maximise positive outcomes for the client.
- Active involvement in service enhancement including development and implementation of relevant policies and procedures
- Provide education and support to staff in RACF to assist in the management of clients
- To ensure accurate documentation is comprehensive and completed including use of all relevant IT systems.

Organisational Responsibilities

- Participate in team/departmental meetings and other organisational meetings as required.
- Maintain comprehensive, accurate client records and a high standard of documentation.
- Participate in relevant research and quality projects related to the area of practice.
- Liaise with other internal and external services to facilitate positive client outcomes.
- Identify own learning needs and demonstrate commitment to ongoing professional development.

Key Selection Criteria

Essential

- Current registration as a Division 1 Registered Nurse with Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA).
- 2. Demonstrated post graduate training or extensive clinical nursing experience including management of acute, aged care, and chronic medical conditions
- 3. Demonstrated skills in assessment, intervention, counselling and complex care planning
- 4. Demonstrated understanding of the impact of hospitalisation on older people with the ability to recognise and respond to change in the medical conditions of clients
- 5. Knowledge of the current issues impacting on the residential care sector.
- 6. Demonstrated ability to work autonomously with highly developed skills in organisation, time management, planning and priority setting
- 7. Demonstrated highly developed verbal and written communication skills with the ability to interact effectively with patients, carers, staff and the community
