## ABOUT THE COURSE



If you have a passion for critical care nursing, this is the course for you!

First apply for a place in the course based in the Intensive Care at BH.

If successful enrol in the Graduate Certificate of Critical Care Nursing with Deakin University.

You will:

- Complete study a graduate certificate level over 12 months
- Be employed 0.7EFT in the Intensive Care Unit (IC) at BH for the 12 months course duration.
- Develop the knowledge and clinical patient care skills required to provide safe and effective nursing care for unstable, critically ill patients.
- Complete rotations to the Emergency Department, Cardiac Catheter Laboratory and Anaesthesia.
- Participate in a program of tutorials and BH study days to support the university academic requirements and to facilitate knowledge translation, continuing development and enhanced quality care.
- Be supported with study leave and clinical teaching.

## OUR DEPARTMENT

The ICU is a modern, well-equipped unit where therapies such as mechanical ventilation, renal replacement therapy, inotropic infusions, temporary transvenous pacing and other advanced interventions are used to support the recovery of critically ill patients across the lifespan. Patients are also admitted for peri percutaneous coronary intervention care and other aspects of coronary care. Nurses utilise advanced haemodynamic monitoring and other advanced assessment to provide close surveillance of patients. The ICU has an experienced team of clinicians who are committed to supporting your learning.
