ABOUT THE COURSE

If you have a passion for emergency nursing, this is the course for you! First apply for a place in the course with Bendigo Health (BH)

If successful enroll in a Master of Advanced Clinical Nursing (Emergency) with Monash University. You will:

- Complete study at a graduate diploma level over 12 months with the option to exit or continue studying to complete a master of nursing.
- Be employed 0.7EFT in the Emergency Department (ED) at BH for the 12 months course duration.
- Develop the knowledge and patient care skills required to provide safe and effective nursing care for emergency patients across the lifespan.
- Complete rotations to the Intensive Care Unit, Cardiac Catheter Laboratory and Anaesthesia.
- Participate in a program of tutorials and BH study days to support the university academic requirements and to facilitate knowledge translation, continuing development and enhanced quality care.
- Be supported with study leave and clinical teaching.

OUR DEPARTMENT

These include emergency trauma, coronary care, paediatrics, obstetrics, mental health, resuscitation patients and many others. Course participants will provide care in a variety of emergency settings including resuscitation, triage and ambulatory care and will develop sound assessment and management skills.
