

FAQ's for Nursing, Midwifery, Paramedicine and Allied Health students

When will I be sent my roster?

- Nursing/Paramedicine/Midwifery students - Your education provider will send you your roster prior to placement commencing.
 - Allied Health students – This information will be available from your education provider or supervisor.
- Once rosters are finalised it is very unlikely rostering requests will be facilitated.**

ICT Access and Pre-learning requirements problems?

An email issued to you approximately 10 days before your placement advises you of your ICT log in details. These user details along with your new password will be used for each placement you attend at Bendigo Health. Carefully follow the instructions outlined in this email to log in and access the GOLD learning management system. You should then complete your mandatory pre-placement training modules. GOLD should be checked prior to each placement as new modules are released regularly. If there is nothing to see in “My Learning” your requirements are up to date. **Completion of the student orientation module is mandatory and will provide you with important information and expectations for your placement.**

How do I arrange accommodation for my placement?

If you require accommodation for your placement, some options are provided below. You will need to contact the accommodation facilities directly to arrange accommodation.

- Monash University campus in Bendigo offers accommodation for students from all education providers undertaking a regional placement. <https://www.monash.edu/medicine/rural-health/placements/accommodation>
- The Graduate Bendigo. This is a private facility on Murphy St, East Bendigo, approximately 10-15 minute commute. The Graduate is well connected with the local bus service at the front door. Where can I park?

Free off-street parking is available in the streets surrounding the hospital campus. Parking in the hospital carpark is reserved for patients and visitors only.

Where do I go on the first day of placement?

Present to the ward or department at the time shown on your roster. For Nursing, Midwifery and Paramedicine students, wayfinding information can be located in the Undergraduate Orientation Guide.

What do I do if I am unwell and can't attend placement?

If you are unwell, do not attend placement until you are fully recovered. You must call the ward or department to advise you will not be attending. You should also notify your education provider that you are not attending. Your education provider is responsible for determining and arranging makeup days. Please discuss this directly with them, not your supervisor.
