

Postgraduate Study in Anaesthetics Nursing

Preparing nurses for working in anaesthetics and recovery

About the Course

The Graduate Certificate in Clinical Nursing Anaesthesia is undertaken in partnership with Bendigo Health and Australian Catholic University (ACU). Students study two subjects online with ACU and undertake two subjects and the clinical practice requirements in anaesthetics and recovery at Bendigo Health. The course is structured to enable students to enhance their theoretical knowledge base, clinical skills and attributes specific to evidence based perianaesthetic patient care.



- The course is 12 months duration, beginning at the start of January
- Positions with students employed part time (0.74 EFT) as registered nurses at Bendigo Health during the course
- Students undertake clinical rotations in anaesthetics and recovery as well as advanced anaesthetic specialty rotations in second semester and a short two day rotation to ICU
- There is a supernumerary period to support transition across the areas & specialties
- Clinical skills competencies complement with theoretical knowledge and skills acquisition
- Scholarships of up to \$5000 per successful applicant*

Our Facilities

The Interventional Suite comprises day of surgery admissions, 11 modern and well equipped operating theatres, a post anaesthetic care unit, central sterilising department and cardiac catheter laboratory.
