#### **About the Course**

If you have a passion for intensive care nursing, this is the course for you! You should first apply for a place in the course with Bendigo Health (BH) and if successful enroll in the Master of Advanced Clinical Nursing (Intensive Care) with Monash University. You will:

- Complete study at a graduate certificate level over 12 months with the option to exit or to continue studying to complete a master of nursing.
- Be employed 0.74EFT in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) at BH for the 12 months duration of the course.
- Develop the knowledge and clinical patient care skills required to provide safe and effective nursing care for unstable, critically ill patients.
- Complete rotations to the Emergency Department, Cardiac Catheter Laboratory and Anaesthesia.
- Participate in a program of tutorials and BH study days to supplement the university academic requirements and to facilitate knowledge translation, continuing development and enhanced quality patient care.
- Be supported with study leave, scholarship opportunities and clinical educators.

## **Our Department**

The ICU is a modern, well equipped unit where therapies such as mechanical ventilation, renal replacement therapy, inotropic infusions, temporary transvenous pacing and other advanced interventions are used to support the recovery of critically ill patients. Nurses utilise advanced haemodynamic monitoring and other advanced assessment to provide close surveillance of patients. The ICU has an experienced team of clinicians who are committed to supporting your learning. Patients are also admitted for peri percutaneous coronary intervention care and other aspects of coronary care.
