If you have a passion for nursing within the Medical Imaging department and caring for both in and outpatient as they undergo a variety of different procedures and/or investigations, then this is the course for you!

Undertaking post graduate studies in Medical Imaging will enable you to enhance your theoretical knowledge base and clinical patient care skills in a supported environment

- The course is facilitated in conjunction with LaTrobe University and begins in February each year
- You will enroll in the Masters of Nursing (Medical Imaging) with the option to exit at a later date at with a Post Grad Diploma.
- Preference for you to be working at least 0.6 EFT in the area. However hours outside this will be discussed on an individual basis.
- Three subjects with LaTrobe University. Two six week subjects that are facilitated back to back in semester 1. Followed by one larger subject in semester 2. These subjects are constructed together to provide you with key postgraduate nursing knowledge whilst providing you with the building blocks to build upon your knowledge as it applies to nursing in the medical imaging department.
- Clinical Hurdles will be developed to challenge your knowledge and skills in the Bendigo Health setting.
