Some facts:

- You can lose 90% of kidney function before symptoms appear
- 1 in 3 adult Australians are at risk of kidney disease
- Kidney Health Australia launched the #nofilter campaign in September 2020

• 6 things healthy kidneys do

- Regulate the body's fluid levels
- Filter wastes and toxins from the blood
- Release a hormone that regulates blood pressure
- Activate vitamin D to maintain healthy bones
- Release the hormone that directs production of red blood cells
- Keep blood minerals in balance (sodium, phosphorus, potassium)
